

**Site:** Mt. Hermon/Nimrod's Castle

**Scripture References:** Genesis 10; Matthew 17:5; John 1:14; 2 Peter 1:16-18; Hebrews 12:2

**Historical Significance:**

1. Tallest mountain in Israel at 9,292 feet.
2. Many people believe that the Transfiguration took place on this mountain because scripture uses the term "high mountain".
3. Nimrod's Castle is located on the southern slopes of Mt. Hermon. It is the biggest Crusade-era castle in all of Israel.

**Things to look for:**

1. Snow capped peaks of Mt. Hermon.

**What does this site teach us about God?**

1. Only the promise of the coming glory gives us the stamina to follow a crucified savior and put aside selfish ambitions.
2. Transfiguration shows that the Kingdom will come!
