

Site: Palm Sunday Road

Scripture References:

Zechariah 9:9

Matthew 21:2-11

John 12:12-16

Mark 11:1-11

Historical Significance:

- The biblical road that Jesus followed when he entered into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday, exactly a week before his resurrection
- Begins at Mount of Olives and leads past several holy sites, including the Garden of Gethsemane and Pater Noster Church, and ends inside the Old city of Jerusalem which is a little less than a kilometer

Things to look for:

- Jewish Cemetery, the shape of the tombstone above the ground and person 6 feet under the ground. Once a year there is a memorial service so there is a cutout in the tombstone to place a candle
- A stone is placed on the tombstone every time someone visits
- Rocks on the side of the road are original

What does this site teach us about God?

- A reminder of the welcoming of Jesus into our hearts and of our willingness to follow him
