Rebuilding Godly Altars

1. RESTORATION OF BROKEN ALTARS

Judges 6:25–26 – Now it came to pass the same night that the Lord said to him, “Take your father’s young bull, the second bull of seven years old, and tear down the altar of Baal that your father has, and cut down the wooden image that is beside it; 26 and build an altar to the Lord your God on top of this rock in the proper arrangement, and take the second bull and offer a burnt sacrifice with the wood of the image which you shall cut down.”

1 Kings 18:30 – Then Elijah said to all the people, “Come near to me.” So all the people came near to him. And he repaired the altar of the Lord that was broken down.

Prayer Points

1. Every broken altar in our lives is restored in the name of Jesus.
2. Foundations that were destroyed are rebuilt by divine power.
3. Let the altar of true worship be re-established within us.

2. REPENTANCE AND CLEANSING

2 Chronicles 7:14 – If My people who are called by My name will humble themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land.

Psalms 51:17 – The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit, A broken and a contrite heart—These, O God, You will not despise.

Prayer Points

1. Every defilement upon our spiritual altars is cleansed by the blood of Jesus.
2. Let hearts of repentance be formed within us.
3. All iniquities hindering our altars are purged.

3. REVIVAL OF PRAYER FIRE

Leviticus 6:12 – And the fire on the altar shall be kept burning on it; it shall not be put out. And the priest shall burn wood on it every morning, and lay the burnt offering in order on it; and he shall burn on it the fat of the peace offerings.

Romans 12:11 – not lagging in diligence, fervent in spirit, serving the Lord;

Prayer Points

1. The fire upon our altars is rekindled continually.
2. Spiritual laziness is replaced with fervency in us.
3. A consistent prayer life is established within us.

4. ALIGNMENT WITH GOD'S WILL

Romans 12:2 – And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.

Matthew 6:10 – Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven.

Prayer Points

1. Our lives are aligned with divine purpose.
2. Every deviation from God's will is corrected in us.
3. Obedience is established as a lifestyle within us.

5. RESTORATION OF SPIRITUAL DISCERNMENT

Hebrews 5:14 – But solid food belongs to those who are of full age, that is, those who by reason of [b]use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.

1 Corinthians 2:14 – But the natural man does not receive the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him; nor can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned.

Prayer Points

1. Spiritual discernment is restored within us in the name of Jesus.
2. Every form of spiritual blindness is removed from us.
3. The ability to distinguish between truth and error is established within us.

6. ESTABLISHMENT OF RIGHTEOUS FOUNDATIONS

Psalm 11:3 – If the foundations are destroyed, What can the righteous do?

Isaiah 28:16 –Therefore thus says the Lord God: “Behold, I lay in Zion a stone for a foundation, A tried stone, a precious cornerstone, a sure foundation; Whoever believes will not act hastily.

Prayer Points

1. A righteous foundation is laid in our lives.
2. Every faulty spiritual foundation is uprooted from us.
3. Stability in God is established within us.

7. RENEWAL OF COVENANT WITH GOD

Genesis 17:7 – And I will establish My covenant between Me and you and your descendants after you in their generations, for an everlasting covenant, to be God to you and your descendants after you.

Hebrews 8:10 – For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the Lord: I will put My laws in their mind and write them on their hearts; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people.

Prayer Points

1. Our covenant relationship with God is renewed.
2. Divine promises are activated in our lives.
3. Faithfulness to God is strengthened within us.

8. ACTIVATION OF DIVINE PRESENCE

Exodus 20:24 – An altar of earth you shall make for Me, and you shall sacrifice on it your burnt offerings and your peace offerings, your sheep and your oxen. In every place where I record My name I will come to you, and I will bless you.

Psalm 26:8 – Lord, I have loved the habitation of Your house, and the place where Your glory dwells.

Prayer Points

1. The presence of God is manifested upon our altars.
2. Our lives are transformed into dwelling places for God.
3. Fellowship with God is deepened within us.

9. SACRIFICE OF PRAISE AND WORSHIP

Hebrews 13:15 – Therefore by Him let us continually offer the sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of our lips, giving thanks to His name.

Psalm 100:4 – Enter into His gates with thanksgiving, and into His courts with praise. Be thankful to Him, and bless His name.

Prayer Points

1. Continuous praise is offered from our altars.
2. Hearts of gratitude are cultivated within us.
3. Worship in spirit and truth is established among us.

10. HOLINESS AND CONSECRATION

1 Peter 1:16 – because it is written, “Be holy, for I am holy.”

Romans 6:13 – And do not present your members as instruments of unrighteousness to sin, but present yourselves to God as being alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness to God.

Prayer Points

1. Our lives are consecrated for holy use.
2. Every impurity is removed from our altars.
3. Holiness is established as our identity.

11. SPIRITUAL AUTHORITY AND DOMINION

Luke 10:19 – Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

Genesis 1:28 – Then God blessed them, and God said to them, “Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it; have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth.”

Prayer Points

1. Authority over the enemy is restored to us.
2. Dominion in every area of life is established for us.
3. Power to overcome is released upon us.

12. HEALING AND RESTORATION

Jeremiah 30:17 – For I will restore health to you and heal you of your wounds,’ says the Lord, ‘Because they called you an outcast saying: “This is Zion; No one seeks her.” ’

Psalm 103:3 – Who forgives all your iniquities, who heals all your diseases,”

Prayer Points

1. Every broken area of our lives is healed.
2. Restoration is released upon our spirit, soul, and body.
3. Losses are divinely recovered for us.

13. SENSITIVITY TO THE HOLY SPIRIT

John 16:13 – However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come.

Galatians 5:25 – If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit.

Prayer Points

1. Spiritual sensitivity is heightened within us.
2. The voice of the Holy Spirit is clearly discerned by us.
3. Guidance by the Spirit is established within us.

14. ESTABLISHMENT OF A CONSISTENT SACRIFICIAL LIFE

Romans 12:1 – I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service.

Psalms 141:2 – Let my prayer be set before You as incense, the lifting up of my hands as the evening sacrifice.

1. Our lives are presented continually as living sacrifices unto God.
2. A lifestyle of daily sacrifice and devotion is established within us.
3. Our prayers and offerings are accepted as a sweet incense before God.

15. FAITH AND SPIRITUAL STRENGTH

Hebrews 11:6 – But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.

Ephesians 6:10 – Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might.

Prayer Points

1. Our faith is strengthened daily.
2. Spiritual endurance is developed within us.
3. Confidence in God is firmly established in us.

16. FRUITFULNESS AND PRODUCTIVITY

John 15:5 – “I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing.

Psalms 1:3 – He shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that brings forth its fruit in its season, whose leaf also shall not wither; and whatever he does shall prosper.

Prayer Points

1. Fruitfulness in every area of our lives is released.
2. Spiritual productivity is increased within us.
3. Our lives are made channels of blessing.

17. CONTINUOUS FELLOWSHIP WITH GOD

James 4:8 – Draw near to God and He will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners; and purify your hearts, you double-minded.

1 Thessalonians 5:17 – Pray without ceasing,

1. A lifestyle of constant fellowship with God is established within us.
2. Our altars are maintained daily without fail.
3. Intimacy with God is deepened continually within us.
