REFINEMENT AND PURIFICATION

1. THE FIRE OF DIVINE REFINEMENT

1 Peter 4:17 – For the time has come for judgment to begin at the house of God; and if it begins with us first, what will be the end of those who do not obey the gospel of God?

Malachi 3:2 – He will sit as a refiner and a purifier of silver; He will purify the sons of Levi, And purge them as gold and silver, That they may offer to the Lord An offering in righteousness.

Prayer Points

1. Father, let every area of our lives be subjected to Your holy refining fire.
2. Let every impurity, compromise, and hidden corruption be removed from us.
3. Let a people acceptable unto You be raised up through divine purification.

2. PURIFICATION OF THE HEART

Psalms 51:10 – Create in me a clean heart, O God, And renew a steadfast spirit within me.

Matthew 5:8 – Blessed are the pure in heart, For they shall see God.

Prayer Points

1. Let clean hearts be created within us by the Spirit of God.
2. Let every defilement of the inner man be washed away.
3. Let purity of motives, thoughts, and desires be established in us.

3. PURGED FOR RIGHTEOUSNESS

1 Peter 4:17 – The Lord begins His work of judgment and purification among His people.

Ezekiel 36:25– Then I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you shall be clean; I will cleanse you from all your filthiness and from all your idols.

Prayer Points

1. Let every work requiring correction in our lives be brought under Your holy purging.
2. Let every weight, hindrance, and ungodly influence be removed from among us.
3. Let the fruit of righteousness and obedience be produced through Your loving correction.

4. REPENTANCE AND SELF-EXAMINATION

1 Corinthians 11:31 – For if we would judge ourselves, we would not be judged.

Lamentations 3:40 – Let us search out and examine our ways, And turn back to the Lord;

Prayer Points

1. Let sincere repentance be granted unto us.
2. Let every blind spot be revealed by the Holy Spirit.
3. Let our ways be examined and aligned with God's will.

5. DELIVERANCE FROM LUKEWARMNESS

Revelation 3: 16 – So then, because you are lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will vomit you out of My mouth.

Romans 12:11 – not lagging in diligence, fervent in spirit, serving the Lord;

Prayer Points

1. Let every spirit of complacency and lukewarmness be broken.
2. Let fresh zeal and passion for God be restored.
3. Let fervency in prayer and service be established among us.

6. PURIFICATION THROUGH THE WORD

John 15:3 – You are already clean because of the word which I have spoken to you.

Ephesians 5:26 – That He might sanctify and cleanse her with the washing of water by the word,

Prayer Points

1. Let the cleansing power of God's Word wash over us continually.
2. Let every lie and deception be uprooted from our minds.
3. Let truth sanctify and strengthen us daily.

7. HOLINESS UNTO THE LORD

1 Peter 1:15–16 –But as He who called you is holy, you also be holy in all your conduct, because it is written, "Be holy, for I am holy."

Hebrews 12:14 – Pursue peace with all people, and holiness, without which no one will see the Lord:

Prayer Points

1. Let holiness become the standard of our lives.
2. Let grace be released for holy living.
3. Let every unclean habit lose its hold over us.

8. REFINEMENT THROUGH TRIALS

James 1:2–3 – My brethren, count it all joy when you fall into various trials, knowing that the testing of your faith produces patience.

Job 23:10 – But He knows the way that I take; When He has tested me, I shall come forth as gold

Prayer Points

1. Let every trial produce maturity and spiritual strength in us.
2. Let faith emerge purified as gold.
3. Let endurance have its perfect work in our lives.

9. CLEANSING OF THE TONGUE

Isaiah 6:7 – And he touched my mouth with it, and said: "Behold, this has touched your lips; Your iniquity is taken away, And your sin purged."

Ephesians 4:29 – Let no corrupt word proceed out of your mouth, but what is good for necessary edification, that it may impart grace to the hearers.

Prayer Points

1. Let our speech be purified by divine fire.
2. Let every corrupt and destructive word be removed from us.
3. Let grace-filled and edifying speech proceed from our mouths.

10. CONSECRATION FOR GOD'S PURPOSES

Romans 12:2 – And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.

2 Timothy 2:21 – Therefore if anyone cleanses himself from the latter, he will be a vessel for honor, sanctified and useful for the Master, prepared for every good work.

Prayer Points

1. Let our lives become vessels fit for the Master's use.
2. Let complete consecration be established in us.
3. Let divine purposes be fulfilled through purified lives.

11. PURIFICATION OF THE CHURCH

Ephesians 5:27 – That He might present her to Himself a glorious church, not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing, but that she should be holy and without blemish.

Acts 15:9 – And made no distinction between us and them, purifying their hearts by faith.

Prayer Points

1. Let the Church be purified and strengthened.

2. Let every work of corruption be uprooted from among us.
3. Let holiness and truth prevail in the Body of Christ.

12. DELIVERANCE FROM WORLDLINESS

1 John 2:15–17 – For all that is in the world--the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life--is not of the Father but is of the world.

James 4:4 – Adulterers and adulteresses! Do you not know that friendship with the world is enmity with God? Whoever therefore wants to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God.

Prayer Points

1. Let every worldly attachment be broken from our lives.
2. Let greater affection for God be established within us.
3. Let eternal priorities govern our decisions.

13. THE FEAR OF THE LORD

Proverbs 8:13 – The fear of the Lord is to hate evil; Pride and arrogance and the evil way And the perverse mouth I hate

2 Corinthians 7:1 – Therefore, having these promises, beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God.

Prayer Points

1. Let the fear of the Lord increase within us.
2. Let every form of evil be rejected and forsaken.
3. Let reverence for God govern our actions and choices.

14. PREPARATION FOR THE COMING OF THE LORD

1 John 3:2 – Beloved, now we are children of God; and it has not yet been revealed what we shall be, but we know that when He is revealed, we shall be like Him, for we shall see Him as He is.

Revelation 19:7 – Let us be glad and rejoice and give Him glory, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and His wife has made herself ready."

Prayer Points

1. Let the Bride of Christ be prepared in purity and holiness.
2. Let every stain, wrinkle, and spiritual compromise be removed from us.
3. Let readiness for the coming of the Lord be established in our hearts.

15. SANCTIFICATION BY THE HOLY SPIRIT

2 Thessalonians 2:13 – But we are bound to give thanks to God always for you, brethren beloved by the Lord, because God from the beginning chose you for salvation through sanctification by the Spirit and belief in the truth,

Galatians 5:16 – I say then: Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh.

Prayer Points

1. Let the sanctifying work of the Holy Spirit increase in us.
2. Let the desires of the flesh be subdued.
3. Let the fruit of the Spirit abound in our lives.

16. PURIFICATION FOR SPIRITUAL POWER

Psalms 24:3–5 – He who has clean hands and a pure heart, Who has not lifted up his soul to an idol, Nor sworn deceitfully.

Acts 1:8 – But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."

Prayer Points

1. Let clean hands and pure hearts qualify us for divine empowerment.
2. Let every hindrance to spiritual authority be removed.
3. Let God's power flow through purified vessels.

17. REFINEMENT FOR GREATER GLORY

Isaiah 48:10 – Behold, I have refined you, but not as silver; I have tested you in the furnace of affliction.

2 Corinthians 3:18 – But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as by the Spirit of the Lord.

Prayer Points

1. Let every refining process produce greater glory in us.
2. Let Christ be revealed more clearly through our lives.
3. Let transformation into His image continually increase.

18. PURITY OF WORSHIP

John 4:23–24 – God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth."

Psalms 24:4 – He who has clean hands and a pure heart, Who has not lifted up his soul to an idol, Nor sworn deceitfully.

Prayer Points

1. Let worship arise from pure hearts before the Lord.
2. Let every form of hypocrisy be removed from us.
3. Let worship in spirit and truth be established among us.
