ABOUT LODGING

While serving in Rapid City we lodge at South Dakota School of Mines and Technology. The campus offers dining and meeting facilities that accommodate our teams well. Participants will sleep in dorm rooms. Each dorm has its own shower and bathroom facilities. Participants need to bring their own bedding: pillows and blankets for a twin size bed. Free time can be spent on designated areas around the campus. Breakfast and dinner will be served in the cafeteria. Lunch will be peanut butter and jelly sandwiches served at the work site. Snacks may be available for purchase or you may bring your own snacks from home.

Transportation:

Participants are responsible for their own transportation to, from, and during the project week. You are able to fly into Rapid City and rent vehicles near the airport. Vans and minivans are recommended. No charter busses, please.

Note: We require at least 25 participants for a mission trip to take place. Do not book your travel plans until Mission Discovery gives the go ahead.
