What to Bring

Woohoo! You're signed up for camp! Now what? Here's a little guide to help you know what to bring (and what not to bring) when you come to camp.

TO BRING

- Bible/Notebook/Pen
- Sleeping Bag or Twin Sized Bedding and Pillow
- A Sweatshirt
- At least 2 pairs of shoes
- Towels (for swimming and showering)
- Toiletries
- Bug Spray
- Flashlight
- Sunscreen
- Money for Canteen (\$20 or less)
- Camera
- Water Bottle
- Prescription Meds (Must be kept with staff in the DC)

NOT TO BRING

- Phones (we mean it)*
- Air Pods
- Other Electronic Devices
- Pocket Knives/Weapons
- Inappropriate Clothing
- Drugs/Alcohol
- Bad Attitudes
- Closed Minds

*** We don't come to camp to be on our phones. Phones should be kept at home or put in a container in the DC we'll have available to be stored for the week. Bring a camera if you want to take pictures. Parents and guardians, if there is an emergency and you need to reach your student, call the number at the top of this page. Help us help them unplug!**

NOTE: We know signing beds/surfaces with permanent markers is nearly a rite of passage at Blackhawk, but if the surface is new/freshly painted students should NOT write in those spaces. Anyone who does will be responsible for fixing/paying to fix the damage caused. Our volunteers work hard to paint and keep up the cabins and we want to honor the work they do!
