Thank you all for your faithful prayers during this season of surgery and healing. I am happy to report that the surgery went very well. I am so thankful that I stayed to have the surgery as the mass was much larger than they initially anticipated. It was definitely responsible for much of the issues I was having and I am recovering nicely. Due to this, I will be able to return to Liberia the end of the month, April 27, Lord willing.

I continue to receive good reports from Titus . We are both equally anxious to see each other. He is doing well in school and has enjoyed times of fellowship with our friends. Maya Clark has helped this time to go so smoothly for him. There has been some news on his immigration application. I will share more if things become definite, but please continue to pray for God's favor and that the file will fall into the hands of just the right people!

It has been a time of healing and renewal for me, both physically and spiritually. It has been a blessing to be with my family, my home church and especially my Mom. Her hospitality and care have been a major factor in my recovery. I have had the chance to calm my spirit and I am ready to head back for the next chapter.

I have had quite a lot of additional expenditures due to my medical needs and needing to change my flight arrangements. I will also need to deal with the need for a new roof for my home and car port before rainy season. We did patching last year but still had significant leaking. Ma Bessie's sons, who are contractors, have offered to provide the labor if I provide the materials. I also have some walls in my home where the plaster is peeling which need repair and repainting. Please pray along with me for provision for these needs and any additional help with these expenses would be very much appreciated!

I have had almost \$2,000 in out of pocket medical expenses (including the purchase of many months of meds and supplements needed for my recovery to take back to Liberia), and \$1,300 in airfare charges for flight date changes. I would estimate the new roof and house repairs would be approximately \$2,000. Thank you for considering and praying for these needs. Any amount helps.

Pray for my upcoming 32 hour flights and layovers! I know it will not be easy physically but even more so emotionally. My Mom has hosted me for 4 long months. It has been such a special time in so many ways. It will not be easy to say good byes, but at the same time I'm so excite to get back to Titus and #myLiberianlife!
