Missionaries to Thailand

Dear Pastor and Church Family,

We pray that you are having a great summer season in your ministries. At the beginning of June, one of my older brothers and his wife were able to visit us. He pastors a church in California, and it is always a great encouragement to have family visit us on the mission field. During their visit, we hosted another Teen Day with around 70 young people in attendance, and my brother was able to preach to the group of teens. One special blessing was that a new group of about twelve young people traveled more than an hour and a half to attend. They all come from Buddhist families, but each one heard the clear message of the Gospel that day. Please pray that they will trust Christ as their Savior, and also pray for the national pastor who is faithfully ministering to them.

This month, we hosted a missions team from the States. We began by traveling to Laos for several days to visit our missionary partners and several of the national pastors supported through CORE Missions. In just three days, we visited five different national pastors and participated in seven services. The team preached, sang, and ministered to children, teens, and adults in each location. It was a tremendous encouragement to hear reports from the pastors and to worship the Lord together despite the many challenges they face.

One highlight of our time in Laos was participating in a Bible in a believer's home about an hour outside of town. It was humbling to see the group of believers gathered in the one-room house, worshipping the Lord together while seated on the floor. They recently secured a small piece of property where they hope to build a church and establish a Gospel witness in their community. Please pray for the rural areas of Laos to be reached with the Gospel, as these communities often experience greater persecution than those in the cities.

After returning to Thailand, we spent the next four days serving together in Chiang Rai. Each day was filled with painting and maintenance projects at two church properties and children's homes, from morning until evening, followed by services each night. We had a few close encounters with scorpions and hornets along the way, but the Lord protected everyone, and we were able to complete many projects at both properties. We also praise the Lord for the evening services where the gospel was clearly presented.

Just this past week, we received important news regarding our new visas. In order for the Thai Embassy to cancel our current visas and process our new long-term missionary visas, our entire family must temporarily leave the country for this final part of the process. After much prayer, we have decided to travel to the Philippines during this time. What first seemed like an inconvenience has become another opportunity from the Lord. We will be able to visit fellow CORE missionaries and national pastors, as well as the CORE Bible Institute of the Philippines, while our visas are being processed. Please pray that everything will be approved quickly and without complications so we can return to Thailand and continue the work God has called us to do.

We also continue to pray for support for two faithful pastors serving in Laos. If your church would be interested in partnering with either of these men or would simply like to learn more about their ministries, I would be happy to answer any questions.

Thank you for your faithful prayers, encouragement, and financial support. Your partnership allows us to continue sharing the Gospel, training leaders, and strengthening churches throughout this region. May God bless you as you serve Him.
