From Virginia to California, we have been in missions conferences and teaching in Bible colleges for the past couple months. The Lord has blessed several of the churches we were in with good faith promise commitments and more young people seriously considering missions in their future. I was able to lecture in the missions classes at West Coast Baptist College and Golden State Baptist College. There is great potential in these students, and we are praying that many will follow God's leading in their lives and serve somewhere on the mission field around the world!



It is a joy for Lori and me to introduce to you our youngest daughter's fiancé, Isaiah Lockwood. He and Julia are engaged to be married the first week of September this year. Isaiah is already a BIMI missionary going to the country of Greenland and has started out on deputation. He is scheduling meetings for the rest of this year and all of 2027. His contacts are at the bottom of his enclosed prayer letter.



I do have to smile thinking that God must have an incredible sense of humor: Isaiah lived in Mexico while his parents served as missionaries there, and Julia was born in Kenya, East Africa, while our family served there. Now, these second generation missionaries are heading to a country where the weather, culture, and language are all strikingly different than where they used to live! It is obvious that God has His hand on this couple, and I know you will want to be a part of their ministry through prayer and possible financial support, if God would so lead.

Meanwhile back in Kenya, our former ministries are working on planting three additional churches this year! They have already targeted these areas through evangelism and are beginning discipleship.

More than two hundred have received Christ and over sixty have been baptized. In one of the three villages, the chief gave our men an abandoned piece of property with an adobe house on site to use as a church building. Repairs are underway to make this building suitable. God is blessing!
