March 2026 - Perhiden: Hope Baptist Church is a city church located in South East Dublin, Ireland. During the summer camps, we take the teens to a nearby park and play various games with them in field. I sat down on a bench next to a young man named Perhiden. Though he spoke Chinese and had little English, thru google translate we had a little chat thru which some gospel was shared. He was highly intelligent, but wary. Later I learned that he had been brutally persecuted by the Chinese government there for being a Uyghur. He visited the next Sunday and has been faithfully attending these last 8 months. He has also come to some Wednesday night men's Bible studies. Many Sundays we have had further opportunities to witness to him. Perhiden, who has no prior knowledge of Christianity, is very cautious and slow to trust. However, he can see that there is something unique about Christianity and the Gospel. We are encouraged by his continued attendance and genuinely seeking after truth. He now seems close to accepting Christ as his Saviour. Please pray for him to be saved!

Louise & Family: We asked you to pray for Louise to be saved and God has answered your prayers. The week after she got saved, she asked Beth to talk with her children, Hannah, 10, and Oliver, 8, about salvation. Hannah definitely understood the Gospel and asked Christ to save her.
