Thank you for praying for the electrical work that needed to be done. It is now completed. We installed 12 exterior lights around the building and fire alarms and security exit lights throughout the building. We are not out of the woods yet on remodeling the building but this was a big step in the right direction. During a recent inspection we were informed that we need to modify the electrical plugs in the nursery to comply with regulations. We plan to do this shortly. **Please pray** for wisdom as we maintain and remodel the church building.

Thank you for giving towards and praying for Project 66 (Le Projet 66). The goal is to guide people through each book of the Bible as well as through other Biblical themes. I have already preached an 8-sermon overview of the story of the Bible and I am almost finished with the first book, Genesis. I planned 10 sermons for Genesis which is just enough to tell the story of Genesis without delving into all the finer points. The plan is to create an email campaign that will guide subscribers through each book of the Bible with additional resources that will improve understanding and application. To do this we need to edit our current sermons, create a newsletter and grow the subscription list, develop each free course and finally, automate the courses through a newsletter platform/email campaign.

If you want to get involved there is room for you to help. I don't want to detail each amount needed but we have multiple monthly subscriptions needed to get the first course out within the next 6 months. All content is already published but we want to refine it and repackage it to make it more accessible to people who do not have access to a local church as well as to those who do have access to a church, but who want to study the Bible, book by book. **Please pray** for these needs.

Please pray for our men's meetings each month. We now gather on Sunday after the service for a meal and study around the word. Last month the men were encouraged and I began to see some of the newcomers talk to each other more than usual. This is encouraging because one of their greatest needs is godly friendships. **Please continue praying** for the women's meetings too; they are a great success. There are several ladies attending in need of Christ.
