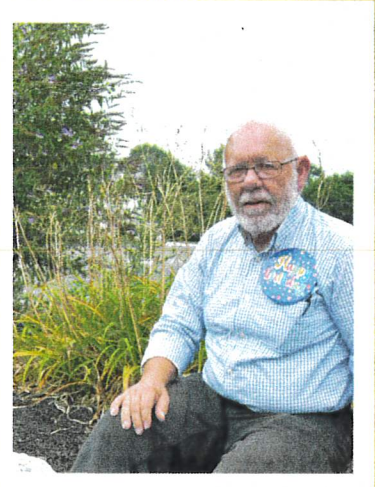
Dear Pastor and friends,
