Dear praying friends & supporters,

Once again, we can truly see just how amazing God has been in His work here on the mission field. It is a blessing that we, and you all over there, are privileged to be part of the eternal salvation of souls! Thank you once again for your involvement in world missions and for your care for my wife and me through your prayers and financial support. The Lord is building His kingdom. To God be all the glory.

We just had our annual church camp and saw about 250 campers just from our church alone. It was amazing to see the eagerness and excitement of new Christians. Our pastor, whom we sent out to the northern province of the island, brought with him about 10 campers, and at the end of January we were privileged to see five of them follow the Lord in believer's baptism. This is a strong testimony of their newfound faith and the change that God has made in each of their hearts. Pastor Emmanuel is leading them in this new church plant. Please pray for them as they continue to grow. We have a special opening revival for that church launch in April. Please pray for souls to be saved at the three-day evangelistic event.



My wife and I will be ministering to Filipinos in Hong Kong this February. Missionary Andrew Au has asked us to come and minister to his Filipino congregation, and we are excited to do so. Please pray for our very busy schedule for the summer months. I will be speaking at the youth camp for Missionary Bruce Rice in Mindanao, and also at the Cebu Baptist Youth Congress in Cebu for Dr. Jesalva and his son, Pastor Kent. They are all dear friends and partners in the ministry. Vacation Bible School is coming up as well, and we are planning for 400 children. We definitely need prayers for that, as well as for the upcoming medical mission on March 21. We are praying to reach 500 patients and share the gospel with each of them on a one-on-one basis.

One of the young men in the church is named Shaun. He is from a broken family and only started coming to church when his friend and neighbor invited him to come for a special Sunday. Shaun came and was wonderfully saved. Since then, he has grown tremendously and has a great testimony of faithfulness. It encourages me to see him always out soulwinning and sharing his testimony with others. He has recently



surrendered to preach and is excited about where that journey will take him. He mentioned once that he has a new family now among the church brethren. It is where he finds his joy and contentment, in the service of the Lord. A young man who once battled feelings of worthlessness and neglect has now been received by a loving Savior and given a church home and family. I am reminded of Psalm 40:2 KJV, “He brought me up also out of an horrible pit, out of the miry clay, and set my feet upon a rock, and established my goings.” What a blessing it is to be saved and then to enjoy the blessings of heaven. We serve a wonderful Savior!

Pray also for a couple that I cannot name right now, but they are heavily involved in communist activism and are allowing me to go through the Bible with them. They have a lot of potential, and even more questions. Please pray for this influential pair, that God will give me the grace I need to influence them to the cross of Christ and ultimately see them saved and grow in grace.

The modern missions movement has expanded to the Philippines! I am personally beyond thrilled to see firsthand what God is doing with Filipino missionaries who are going all over the world, assimilating and starting New Testament local churches. One of our men is going to Taiwan, and he is getting married in March! Please pray for Kleinton as he continues on deputation with his new bride.



Prayer Requests:

- My wife’s American citizenship request has not been fully processed yet on the immigration side, and we do not understand why it is taking this long. We may have to go back later this year to finish processing it, or her green card will be revoked—and then she will not be able to enter back into the US for sure. Please do pray with us for that.
- We are in the process right now of scouting for a campground for our youth Bible camp. Pray that God leads us to the right property and for His provision.
- Pray for wisdom in dealing with the overcrowding issue. We are blessed to have amazing church growth, and with it comes new challenges. Pray for us for wisdom in finding solutions.
- Pray for an 80-year-old man named Michael whom I have met with twice already. He is a former chief engineer and a man of high degree, but he does not know Christ as Savior yet. He is close, though. Please pray for him.
