March has come in like a lion and we are praying that it goes out like a lamb around here! Our family has just returned from an encouraging missions conference with the people of Faith Baptist Church in Pensacola, Florida. It was such an amazing time to rejoice with God's people and share what the Lord is doing through prayer, sacrificial giving, and the hands and feet of those willing to go.

Our small-but-mighty team of twelve worked hard in Togo back in January along with missionary Mike Napper and Camp Hope. Four different village churches participated in the medical campaign and 803 patients were treated with 187 salvation decisions. This was our first time in Togo and we were amazed at what the Lord had planned for us.

In February our team headed out to Cuba. Yes, you read that right- Cuba! We heard over and over how much of a miracle it was that we were allowed entry on a humanitarian visa. Our team of 34 experienced Tribe Members worked with national pastors to see over 2,000 patients. We had several hundred people profess Christ and dozens more who scheduled home visits to hear more about the gospel. While our Cuban brothers and sisters are suffering from lack of basic necessities, the church there is thriving!

Our Rearick Surgical Center is also thriving. I (Kelly) had the opportunity to meet every patient and perform histories and physicals prior to the surgical week. The patients were so excited for the opportunity to receive life-changing procedures. Praise the Lord for the people of Beacon Baptist Church and their willingness to share the gospel with every single patient and their family members. Our general and orthopedic surgeons performed thirty surgeries and thirteen people accepted Christ!

Bradley will be speaking at a conference at Camp Creek Baptist Church in Cornelia, Georgia tonight. He will be preaching at Strong Rock Christian School next week. Please pray for all who hear- that they would be stirred by the call to missions.

Next week we have three teams heading out simultaneously. We have two teams headed to two different locations in the Dominican Republic (96 team members total) while a third team heads to Kenya. Please be in prayer for safety, smooth customs experiences, and for the gospel to go forth in miraculous ways.

God is working all over the world and we are just so happy to be a part of His work. Thank you for your support.
