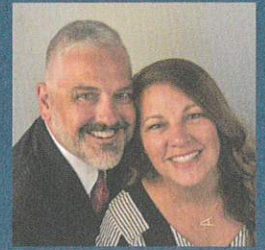




The *Hall* Family

There were over 50 churches represented at the conference. 32 national pastors, and 8 missionaries were delegates along with 21 other churches who had members at the conference. Holmes, Missionary Evangelist Denton Bell, Pastor and Mrs. Justin Nenge, Missionary Pat Hamburg, and I all traveled to the Southeast part of Nigeria to a city called Calabar. There we were a part of their 6th Soul Winning and Leadership Conference at Independent Baptist Church hosted by Pastor Nicholas Wayiah. Pastor Wayiah is one of the godliest men I have ever had the pleasure of meeting. This was my third time to get to preach for him. There were 20 national pastors in attendance at that conference.


Speaking of conferences, Maranatha Baptist Church of Newburgh, IN will be hosting our 5th annual Midwest regional BEST Missions Bible Conference this coming May 3- 5. Pastor John Wilkerson, Bro. Samuel Martin, and I will be speaking. We will have regular Sunday services as well as services on Monday and Tuesday evening at 6:30pm and Tuesday morning at 10am with lunch to follow. These conferences are designed to help and encourage attendees to the needs and opportunities to get the Gospel and Word of God out.
