Church Planting Missionaries to Germany

Eph. 3:20 - Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us,

In our last prayer letter, we shared how the Lord allowed us to pass out gift bags at the university. There, God allowed us to meet a university student who is part of a nationwide German Bible study group. He invited us to their first Bible study of the semester, where we met an English speaker who desired to start an English Bible study group. After speaking with him, we learned that the Lord had placed this burden on his heart a year ago, around the time we stepped out in faith by preparing gift bags even though we had not received permission. It was so encouraging to see how the Lord was working in both of our hearts and leading us together. This young man began making plans and inviting people, but was not sure what to speak on. He later contacted Brandon and said that God impressed on him to ask Brandon to preach to the group of students. God orchestrated so much that the testimonies shared that night, before the sermon, perfectly complemented the sermon. Praise God, there were more than twenty students who attended. Several of them later visited our church because of that meeting.

There is much work to be done here and in the surrounding countries. God has given our family the opportunity to attend a gospel meeting in the Netherlands. A group of believers meets once a month for two nights of preaching and encouragement, and they desire a pastor to start a church. Another area of need is in the nearby country of Luxembourg. Brandon has been contacted by an elderly gentleman who couldn't find a church near him. He desires a church in his area and has offered to let Brandon use his house for meetings. As our church grows, we also see the need for help. Would you help pray for God to send laborers to the mission fields here? There is much to be done for the Lord, and time is quickly fleeting. Please help us pray for wisdom, direction, and the Lord's provision in all of these areas.

As we write this letter, we are making our final preparations for our first furlough. Thank you for helping us pray! So far, we have a full schedule of meetings, a van rented, and a few places lined up to stay. Due to restrictions, we cannot be out of the country for too long; otherwise, our visas will become invalid. Since it would be impossible for us to visit every supporting church in that time, we have created an update video to share. It will be available for download and shown at your convenience. Please continue to pray for traveling mercies, for our family to be a blessing and encouragement, for Reese as she transitions into college life, and for our family as we transition to daily life without her. We enjoyed celebrating her last year in her teens at church recently with a small surprise birthday party. We praise God for her love for the Lord, her influence on others, and her sweet, obedient spirit!
