## Church Planting Missionaries to Germany

What a blessing it is to write to our praying family and friends. Brandon has begun his third of five German courses. Though each course is more complex, God has helped his vocabulary, fluency, and influence to grow. In one of his classes, a man from Hungary had a significant seizure. Brandon and another classmate cared for him until the ambulance arrived. It caught everyone off guard, and a few people were visibly shaken. God used Brandon to help calm and encourage them. Please continue to pray for Brandon to retain the information he is learning and to be a light to his classmates.

God gave us a divine appointment at church last month. We met a former member of the church we are serving at. She lives in America but was here for a short visit to see her family. She asked if we could meet later in the week. When we met for tea, she shared her burden for her brother. She is unsure of his salvation and asked us to reach out to him. Miraculously, he lives in the same area as Caspar, the German man we have asked for prayer about before. Please continue to pray for Caspar and now Markus. Please pray that God would open their eyes to Him and give them victory over addiction to alcohol and pharmaceuticals.

God has given Tabitha the opportunity to help in a teen girl's class on Wednesday nights. Another lady leads the class, and Tabitha teaches a bible lesson. She has also been able to teach a Children's church for a month while the Pastors wife is out of town. Our family has been invited to a German church just over an hour away to speak at their Missions Conference. Brandon will preach in English but will be giving our testimony in German. Please pray that God will use him during the service and help him as he formally uses German for the first time in church.

Tabitha recently had pain in her back that gradually intensified and spread around her side. We decided that she should be checked out. I took her to the local emergency room, and they ran several tests. She spent several days in the hospital for a significant kidney infection. We aren't sure what caused it exactly, but we are thankful that God has brought her through. She is doing much better but has other tests that need to be done soon. Please pray that God will give us answers and wisdom to her doctors.

We know many missionaries do not have anyone they can leave their children with in emergency situations. God has blessed us with incredible friends here that have ministered to us in more ways than we could mention!

We have received many emails congratulating us on our anniversary, asking for specific prayer requests, and even offers to send us things from home. It is tremendously encouraging to know that people pray for us and care about our family.
