August 2025

In just a couple weeks, CRL will be celebrating the completion of its 50th year of broadcasting the Gospel to the Eastern Caribbean islands from the island of Antigua! For the past year, we've been planning and preparing the details of the **Anniversary Service** to be held on **Sunday, September 7th at 10:00am!** Evangelist Dr. Steve Pettit will still be our special speaker, but the musical team is no longer able to join us. Instead, Pastor Kevin Inafuku has graciously agreed to assist with special music at the service. Pastor Inafuku's voice is known to our listeners through several of his songs in our music library. We will try to stream the service. Please look for announcements via email or our Facebook page for the streaming details. The following week, we also plan to have an Open House, where listeners can tour the studio and receive additional CRL gifts! Please keep this service in your prayers!

Of course, the regular daily duties of maintaining a radio station continue! Our Caribbean staff continues to diligently prepare programs for broadcast each day. In recent months, the age of our equipment is really showing. I have had to replace an STL transmitter and receiver (\$5,200), several UPS battery backups (\$4,200), a water pressure tank (\$760), and I'm in the process of installing a new generator at our studio site. All of these pieces of equipment have continued well past their life expectancy, and we thank the Lord for that! If you'd like to donate toward any of these items, funds can be sent to our mission board, BIMI, Account #243.

During the summer our ministry apartments have housed guests almost non-stop! At the end of May, we had a special visitor, Mrs. Sharon Steel, who was a missionary at CRL in the late 1980's, and her grandson came to help with various projects. At the end of June, we had a team that conducted a VBS at one of our local churches, where the Gospel was beautifully presented each day. We then housed a group from Child Evangelism Fellowship, who did evangelism training and held several Bible clubs. Following that, another mission team came to run a VBS at another local church. And finally, one of our Antiguan churches used an apartment for their youth camp, shielding their youth from the wicked, reveling, Carnival activities. We're grateful for the facilities to assist the local churches in this way!

Please continue to pray that the Lord directs a technically-minded missionary to help at CRL full time! Please continue to pray for us during hurricane season! And of course, please pray for the 50th Anniversary Service. We want the Lord to be honored and glorified through all that we do and say! We also know that we have many listeners who are not truly born-again believers, and we pray that the Gospel is clearly taught and understood.
