For 8 years we've asked you to pray with us for additional, technical, missionary personnel for Caribbean Radio Lighthouse... In 2024, a friend of a friend introduced us to Andrew and Summer Chafa.

Being saved personally, through radio outreach as adults, the Chafas are extremely passionate about the radio ministry. Since 2019, the Chafas have been surrendered to missions, specifically in radio and media. For four years they self-funded trips to help install radio stations around the world. It was then the Lord led them to sell their transportation and construction/handyman business to begin full-time deputation as radio planting missionaries.



Since December 2024, the Chafas have taken three trips to Antigua to help with various projects. The most recent trip was for three months, February to April 2026, to help prepare for the new AM radio transmitter. After spending much time in prayer, the Chafas recently told us that the Lord has given them a peace about moving to Antigua to assist with Caribbean Radio Lighthouse full time! And after working with the Chafas for several months, I also believe they will be a good fit for the CRL ministry!



The Chafas are sent out of [Marion Avenue Baptist Church](#) in Washington, Iowa. They have four adult children and a handful of grandchildren.
