

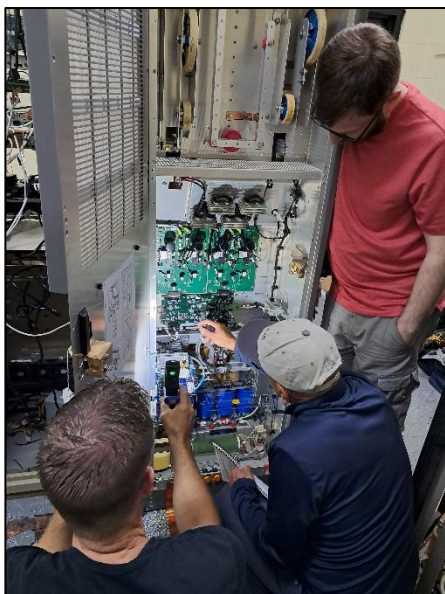


# CARIBBEAN RADIO LIGHTHOUSE

Caribbean Radio Lighthouse can once again be heard with 10,000 watts of transmitting power throughout the Eastern Caribbean islands! The former AM radio transmitter always required a lot of repairs and maintenance, but last October began a series of catastrophic events that made it clear that we desperately needed a new AM radio transmitter. Through the generous financial support and prayers of many of you, we were able to purchase a new \$80,000 AM radio transmitter! It took some time for the transmitter to be built and shipped to us here in Antigua, but by God's grace, the new transmitter arrived late in April. While we waited, we did all that we could to keep the old transmitter broadcasting between 60%-80% power. The technology in AM radio transmitters has changed drastically in 30 years, and there was a lot of preparation and adjustments before we could install the new transmitter. Andrew and Summer Chafa with [Tech2Proclaim Ministries](#) spent three months with us helping prepare for the new transmitter and several other projects. Unfortunately, the transmitter came a little later than we expected, and the Chafas were not able to stay for the final changeover. My brother-in-law, Ryan



Johnsonbaugh, came to help for the week of transition. And on May 14<sup>th</sup>, a technician from the transmitter company came to our site, made a few adjustments, gave instructions for maintenance, and commissioned our new AM radio transmitter! For me, it was such a relief that everything was properly prepared and the transition went smoothly! Thank you to so many who prayed towards that moment! Please pray now that listeners who may not have been able to hear us for the past half-year would tune into the radio station once again, and that with the new equipment our signal would reach even farther!

#### **Addition for Nathan & Renee Owens' Personal Prayer Letter:**

When we began our church's roof replacement project over one year ago, we did not foresee what would happen with CRL's AM radio transmitter. But somehow during the last few months, while juggling keeping the radio station's old transmitter alive and preparing for the new transmitter, we were able to help our church finish the roof project, move everything back in the sanctuary, and on May 10<sup>th</sup> we had our first service in over one year back in the church auditorium! There are still some outside projects to finish, like guttering and an awning over the main entrance, but we're so grateful to be worshipping again in our regular location.



At times the load seemed too much to bear, but the Lord sustained. During a quick trip to the States to transport equipment, Renee was able to have corrective eye surgery (photorefractive keratectomy) and also get examined for chest pain. The doctors believe she has inflammation of the cartilage around her sternum (costochondritis), which requires rest. In June, we hope to take a couple weeks to personally relax and pull away from the radio station and church duties. We will remain in Antigua, but please pray for a time of personal refreshment and healing! We greatly appreciate your prayers for us personally and our ministries in Antigua!
