First, I want to extend an apology for your not receiving a newsletter sooner. As I was beginning to prepare this update, I became aware that I sent out *support reports* in January but had not sent a newsletter. Please forgive me.

We have been very busy with the beginning of a new semester for your Bible college. I am excited that we are showing videos on **The Book of Revelation** preached from our home church pastor – Pastor Tom Gang. It is a verse-by-verse study with very thorough notes. Because of the details and length of the messages, it will be a two-semester class. Early reports say that the students are very much enjoying it.

My friend, Missionary Tony Ledbetter, is teaching a class on Dispensationalism. He will also be traveling with me once again to Liberia on March 10. We will be officially organizing the *Faith Baptist Church in Saclapea*. This is in the interior of Liberia. At this same time, we will be ordaining Ayres Voyee as the pastor. Brother Voyee will soon complete his education in our Bible college. He was assistant pastor to Pastor Saywah at FBC of Thinker Village for several years.

We were able to purchase 3 acres of land last year and are praying for funds to build a church. *If you would be interested in helping please reach out to me.* They are presently meeting in a home.

Along with brother Voyee, we will be ordaining two more of our student / pastors while in Liberia. They have both graduated from our college and have been pastoring for several years.

*Please note that the training of these men and the church plants are a result of your faithful support of our ministry in Liberia. **This is fruit to your account!** We are so very grateful for your partnership with us and helping to reach the lost, train the faithful, and grow the ministry.*
