Hello Friends,

While we've been in the lower 48 we have been able to visit numerous supporting churches, seeing old friends and making new ones. It has been so encouraging as many of these churches have supported us for over 17 years!

Last week we dropped the RIG off at the manufacturer in northern Indiana. There are several items that need to be addressed, some are critical. The main concern is damage caused by rust on the undercarriage, wheel wells, and the supporting framework holding the exterior bins. We are happy to report that one supporting church has already given over \$9,000 to help with some of these needs.

After dropping the RIG off, I took John and Rebekah to Chicago O'Hare airport. They flew back to Alaska in order to attend the last winter trip of the season by snowmachine. John was especially excited about this because the videographer from Lens of the Harvest ministry (Brother Nathan Fry) was on this trip to begin building our son Caleb's deputation video. Caleb's family will begin deputation sometime next year. While Brother Fry was there, he also interviewed John for a video explaining the need for a shop large enough to store and maintain all of the RAM ministry equipment out of the elements. Land clearing for this project began last year and is scheduled to continue as soon as the snow is gone. We are looking forward to both of these videos being complete sometime this summer.

John's mom is getting weaker and has had a couple of setbacks. The last few weeks, Sarah has been staying with her around the clock. Pray that we have wisdom making decisions for her care and any transitions that need to happen. She will soon require 24/7 care.

John and Rebekah fly back to Chicago next week. As soon as the RIG is ready, they will be picking up a new snowmachine trailer for the RAM ministry. They will drop it off in Minnesota for the new pastor of Manna Baptist Church in Palmer, Alaska. We will get to deliver his family's household goods for them on our way home.

Please pray for wisdom and funds for the shop project and RV repairs, as well as Caleb's deputation video, and mom's health.
