Dear Faithful Supporters and Friends,

Every Saturday morning, we have what we call a “fruit-bearing” meeting. It is a combined meeting for our bus workers and soulwinners. About fifteen to twenty people attend the meeting. We have a prayer time followed by singing some Sunday school songs and making some announcements. A brief challenge from the Bible is given, and then we leave for the field to bear fruit. The harvest is always there. The workers, we can always use more.

For March and April, there were **91** saved and **4** baptized. Let me tell you about two of them.

His name is Dakari. He is sixteen. He is one of nine children, many from different mothers. He lives in the inner-city. His neighborhood is the “hood.” Drugs, immorality, crime, and poverty rule the day and the night. Dakari lives on the bus route where I visit. I am his bus captain. There is something about Dakari that is different. He listens in church. He is focused, and sometimes he asks me questions after the service. He is saved and not too long ago, he said, “I will get baptized very soon.” He is fruit.

In another area of the city, there is a man named Gregory. He is in his late sixties and has stage 4 prostate cancer. He is in poor health. He is one of nineteen children, the majority from different mothers. One day we got a call from his sister who lives in America. Her husband is retired from the US Army. She and her husband were discipled and reached for Jesus by American, Independent Baptist missionaries, ministering to US servicemen and women in Germany. She heard of us through FBN Christian radio (Fundamental Broadcasting Network). She asked, “Can you visit my brother?” I told her, “Yes.” I went to his house. He also lives in the “hood.” Gregory willingly accepted Christ as his Savior. He also is fruit. Just think, the Gospel went from half way around the world in Germany to Gregory here in Guyana, South America.

Thank you, friends, for your prayers and investment in us. May the Lord of the harvest continue to use you in His harvest.
