We are one signature away from being able to start the paperwork for his adoption, but his birth mother wants money. She's threatening to not show up May 20th at the court. Please pray.

In February we had a science fair family night at school. I noticed a father wiping his eyes outside the 6th grade classroom. They were tears of joy. He said his boys (3rd and 6th graders) already know more Bible, science, and math than he does. His sixth grader made a hydraulic crane with a syringe and card board.
