For me, it was a return after ten years away; for my wife and children, it marked the beginning of a completely new chapter as we settled into a new home and ministry. In the months leading up to our departure for the field, I was especially moved by a phrase in Ezra 8:36, "... and they **furthered** the people, and the house of God." As we stepped into the established ministry my father, David Solt, has been pastoring, one question kept resonating in our hearts: how could we further the work God was already doing? On that same day one year later, we rejoiced as we joined our youth group in distributing Gospel flyers to more than **400 doors** in our community. Praise the Lord! It has been a joy to witness the remarkable growth of our youth group, both numerically and spiritually.

With the weather warming up, Ruby and Andrew have been enjoying going outside more often. Ruby loves riding her bike and is starting to get faster at peddling. Andrew loves walking in the grass, exploring new things, and watching our neighbor's cows!

God has also furthered our church through training more soul winners, Bible distribution near the local university, growth in our missions program, increased media outreach, the creation of a studio, nursery updates, and a renewed emphasis on personal discipleship. We're aware of our current limitations, but we're praying for God to raise up laborers, trusting Him for the exciting things He has ahead. Thus far in 2026, We have witnessed to **34** souls, rejoiced in seeing **11** accept Christ, and maintained regular discipleship meetings with **7** individuals.

Recapping March and April: We greatly enjoyed having my brothers, Joshua and Jeremy, visit for a couple of weeks, along with Ashley and little Ember (Jeremy's wife and daughter). It was a special time filled with wonderful memories. We were also encouraged by the fellowship of Pastor and Mrs. Tom Lemmons from Lighthouse Baptist Church in Missoula, Montana, and the messages God gave Pastor Lemmons were used powerfully during our church's Anniversary Sunday. We welcomed **9** visitors that Sunday, including a mom and her 2 teenagers who had recently moved from South Africa. After the service, I had the opportunity to speak with both teens and witnessed both of them trust Christ. Praise the Lord! March was also marked by the arrival of a **pallet of Bibles from Word to the World Ministries and Wings Bearing Precious Seed**. What a timely answer to prayer it was! Moving into April, we saw God bring more visitors on Resurrection Sunday services, with **96** in attendance.

Family Update: God is good! We are excited to share that Solt Baby #3 (It's a girl!) is due in October. We covet your prayers, as we plan to have the baby here in England. God has directed us to an excellent pregnancy-care clinic that has recently opened—truly perfect timing. As the political and economic climate here grows more uncertain due to the conflict in Iran, we ask that you pray God would use us, as more people are seeking answers.
