Dear Friends and Fellow Labourers in Christ,

February moved quickly. It was a full month—steady, structured, and quietly productive. There were no dramatic shifts in direction, but there was unmistakable evidence of the Lord’s continued blessing. The work remains consistent, and the pace has not slowed. If January established the rhythm of the year, February strengthened it.

The theme of Stedfast continues to frame our focus. Ministry here does not operate on emotion or novelty; it advances on conviction and constancy. Each week reinforces that the call is not to reinvent the work, but to remain anchored in it.

### **Primary School Outreach**

Our Wednesday ministry within the local primary school continues without interruption. The weekly Bible assembly and eight classroom sessions remain a remarkable open door. The consistency of presence is deepening trust with both pupils and staff. Scripture is being heard clearly and respectfully. Relationships are strengthening. These are not superficial connections; they are long-term investments in families and in the future spiritual landscape of the community.

We do not take this access lightly. It is strategic ground, and we labour carefully upon it.

### **Gym Ministry – FAITH RXD**

The gym ministry remains one of the most effective bridges between the physical and the spiritual. Saturday FAITH RXD sessions are steady and well attended. Conversations that begin around discipline, endurance, and training are naturally transitioning toward truth, repentance, and eternal matters.

Several individuals continue progressing from gym participation into regular church attendance. What begins with physical training is often leading to spiritual inquiry. The integration of strength and Scripture continues to bear fruit.

In addition, we were recently contacted by the **BBC**, who spent time filming and interviewing within both the church and the gym ministry. They are producing a documentary highlighting the work being done here in South Wales. It is scheduled to air in the coming month or two. We view this not as personal recognition, but as providential exposure—an opportunity for the gospel witness of this ministry to reach beyond our immediate region.

We are praying the Lord uses it for His glory.

### **Cynon Valley Campus**

The Cynon Valley campus remains stable and steadfast. Attendance is consistent. The spirit is unified. There is continued resolve among the people to stand firm and move forward together.

The challenges common to church planting in this region remain present, but none are unexpected. The ground is not soft, but it is workable. The labour continues—patiently, deliberately, and biblically.

### **Cardiff Campus**

Cardiff continues to grow in both participation and engagement. The momentum established at the start of the year has held steady. There is increasing involvement in ministry and stronger relational connectivity among the people.

Growth here requires structure and vigilance. We are committed to ensuring that expansion does not outpace depth. The goal remains discipleship, not merely attendance.
