I am not one to publish numbers, Elena and I are in Uganda to serve the Lord Jesus, but we acknowledge these many blessings and give all the praise to the Lord Jesus who has provided them and allows us to temporarily steward them for His glory.

IN NOVEMBER, my right-hand man, Paul, was ordained as a pastor into the ministry. He had been preparing a long time, and despite two Covid shutdowns, and being extremely busy with construction projects, he managed to complete his Bible doctrines course and make it through his ordination examination via four local pastors. It was a happy day for Paul and his family was very proud, and I welcome him as a fellow servant in ministering to his people both in the church and SOAP ministries.
