Four large, new tents were purchased because we did not have enough room to house all the campers.

Each tent will comfortably hold 12 campers and their counselor. We can now receive more campers.



Our perimeter wall for the camp is coming along. We are trying to enclose the property with a wall to prevent theft. We still have a lot to go, but we are so thankful that a wall now stands on the back side. The gate is not in place yet. First a bridge over the irrigation water channel has to be built and then we can hang the gate in place. At this point, we are working on the bridge.

We also have made good progress on the construction of the radio multi-purpose property and housing for one of our radio employees. Another project we are working on is housing for an employee that lives where our radio tower is located.

There is a lot more to do and we are usually working on two or three projects at once. With the crew that we have, there is enough work for at least two more years. By that time, we should have more radio towers to build and a lot more to do on our camp.
