Dear Faithful Prayer Supporters,

Summer 2026

Tamala and I recently celebrated fifty-five years of marriage and are beginning our fifty-first year as missionaries: giving the Gospel, baptizing believers, and planting churches. This has been our purpose and practice in various countries over these many years. Thank each of our supporters for having a part through prayers and financial support. We made a trip to Kenya in March and have a full schedule with many important meetings planned for the remainder of 2026. Please make our scheduled meetings and these upcoming major trips a matter of fervent prayer.

March – April 2026

A leadership conference of the 45 districts of Kenya and three surrounding countries was held during this trip. Meals and fellowship were shared over the two-day meetings. Teaching was done from early morning until late evening. Dr. Seabury Nyabero reported that many wonderful comments were made by the attendees after the conference.

July 2026

Eleven young people will be with us on this trip and will be going into public schools with a Gospel message in preaching, singing, and testimonies, as requested by the President of Kenya. The audience will be made up of from 100 to over 1000 young people from elementary and high schools, universities, and technical and medical schools. The last time this group was in Kenya, the Gospel was given to over 20,000 students. Please pray for them.

September -- October 2026

Over the last 26 years I have been involved in the graduation ceremony for the Bible school, a ministry and highlight of Faith Baptist Church, Eldoret, and the Fellowship of African Independent Baptists (FAIB). More than 50 students are expected to have completed the requirements for graduation this year and over 1,000 people are expected to attend the graduation. It is at the suggestion of the President of Kenya to reach remote areas by using bicycles due to conditions there: no paved roads, electricity, or running water. Even small motorbikes can be useful in some areas. Pray that we will see the Lord do great things with all these graduates.

We are asking the Lord to provide laborers to advance the Gospel by utilizing the following upcoming projects:

- 1. More churches planted in remote areas**
- 2. Fifty (50) bicycles, and two (2) small motorbikes for remote areas**
- 3. One thousand (1,000) Bibles (500 in Swahili and 500 in English, to be printed in Kenya)**
