In February, we celebrated our 22nd Church Anniversary, held on the first Sunday of the month. We had the privilege of hosting Evangelist Don Wattenberger (Crosby, Tennessee), along with my dear friend and colleague, Missionary Mark Holmes.

It was a wonderful day, with close to 700 people in attendance, and we rejoiced to see over 100 souls accept Jesus Christ as Savior. To God be all the glory!

That same evening, we began our special services, followed by a three-day Pastors' and Church Workers' Conference starting on Monday. We thank God for journey mercies granted to all who attended.

We recorded over 200 pastors and church workers from nine states across Nigeria. It was truly a time of sweet fellowship, revival, and spiritual refreshment. Many testimonies have come in, confirming that the Lord used this meeting to strengthen and encourage His servants.

We are humbled that God is using our church to be a blessing to many in ministry.

Currently, our church attendance averages about 350 people weekly, and we are trusting God for continued growth as He faithfully adds to the church.

Please continue to pray for us as we expand and press forward in the work.

We thank the Lord for the steady progress at our church plant, Overcomers Baptist Church. God is helping Bro. Emmanuel Akanji and his family as they faithfully labor in the ministry there.

The need for a solar power system remains important due to ongoing electricity challenges.

Please continue to pray for us for wisdom as we move forward with this plan.

As a family, we are doing well and rejoicing in the Lord's continued goodness. We thank God for His sustaining grace upon our home and for keeping us in good health.

We would like to share that we will be returning to the United States at the end of April to continue the second phase of the process for obtaining permanent Religious Worker authorization. We are pursuing this due to our tax obligations in the U.S., as it will enable us to include my wife and children in my tax filings.

While we are in the U.S., we will continue deputation work—seeking to recover some of the support we have lost over the years, as well as raise funds for ongoing ministry projects. We also look forward to visiting supporting churches we have not seen in several years, in order to give updates and enjoy sweet fellowship together.

Please pray for God's guidance, provision, and favor throughout this process.
