Hello to all in the name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. We want to start by thanking you all for your generous prayers. It has been a great month of July here in Mongolia. The Lord has blessed our annual summer camp with well over 200 people in attendance coming from many of our ministries, including the Gobi desert ministries. We are excited to report that 15 young adults made professions of faith and were baptized. This year, we also invited many of our former church members who have gone and planted many churches across Mongolia. We are so grateful to you all for your prayers and support for our annual summer camp.



We are excited to report that two men were officially ordained to the gospel ministry at camp this year. We praise the Lord for calling Pastor Zolkhuu and Erdenebat to serve His church. We ask that you please pray for them as they take on this blessed responsibility, and that the Lord will use them to reach many souls with the gospel.

After summer camp, we had an opportunity to visit two of our ministries in the Gobi desert, accompanied by guests visiting us all the way from Iowa. It has been an unusual summer with a lot of rain in the desert. On our way back from Saikhan-Ovoo village, our vehicle got stuck in the mud for hours until we received help from local villagers. We hired a local man named Mandakh as our driver. This is the third time he has driven us to the desert villages, and each time we have faithfully witnessed to him. Though he is not a believer yet, we believe that God will save his soul. We ask you to please join us in praying specifically for Mandakh's salvation, that the seeds planted on these trips will soon bear fruit.

Please pray with us that the Lord will provide funds to cover these expenses. We thank you all for your partnership with us in the gospel. You all are a blessing to us, and we love you in our Lord Jesus. We pray that God will keep you in Christ and His grace.
