



Worship services begin each Sunday at 9:15am and 10:45am. We ask all who serve to **arrive 15 minutes prior to the service they are scheduled to oversee.**

FRESH TOUCH

As representatives of the Fresh Touch Ministry, our task is to reduce barriers that might keep worshippers from receiving a fresh touch from God. Thus, we endeavor to be friendly, encouraging and helpful. We have new guests almost every week, so, if possible, gently discover and retain the names of those you don't yet know.

Barista (1 or 2) Our baristas will arrive early enough to have coffee ready by 9:00 am. They will prepare and serve coffee 15 minutes prior to each service. They will be friendly and helpful.

Exterior door greeter (1) Door greeters will warmly greet each arrival and hold the door for them.

Lobby greeter (1) Lobby greeters will greet each arrival warmly and help direct them as needed. They will assist with managing flow of worshippers between services, keeping traffic areas free of congestion. They will encourage everyone to honor exit and entry patterns.

Sanctuary door person (1) The sanctuary door person will station themselves adjacent to the sanctuary door. They will monitor the filling of the sanctuary. As they greet each arrival warmly, they will suggest appropriate seating according to the size of the group entering. They will close the doors at the beginning of service and re-open them at the conclusion of service. For those not attending the service, we ask that you open the door for those entering a service in progress. They will also assist with managing flow of worshippers between services, keeping traffic areas free of congestion. They will encourage everyone to honor exit and entry patterns. They will direct new guests to the "new guest table" – for connect cards and free gifts.

Section greeter (1) The section greeter will be in the sanctuary and will circulate, warmly meeting and greeting those arriving. They will introduce themselves and strive to make each guest comfortable.

Outdoor greeter (2 minimum) The outdoor greeter will carry a two-way radio so we can interact. They will smile and hold the yellow "We have a place for you" sign. They will remain in place 5 minutes after the start of each service (or until traffic subsides) and will resume their position 10 minutes prior to each service. In the event of rain, they will assist those with small children, the elderly or others with special needs.

CHILDREN'S MINISTRY

Our goal is to draw each child and their family closer to the grace and truth of Jesus Christ through a relationship fostered in unconditional love. We offer Nursery (age 0-3) and Kingdom Kids (4 years old to 5th grade) each Sunday at 9:15 and 10:45 am. Parents often arrive early to get children settled before service and we want to be sure someone is there to greet them, so please arrive 15 minutes prior to your service time. Volunteering in children's ministry is a month on/month off commitment. A background check is required.

Check-In Greeter (2) Kid Check In Greeters will check in each volunteer and family using our KidCheck program. They will enter an individual or family phone number and a tag will print out.

Nursery (2) Nursery volunteers will warmly greet each child/family. They will assist parents in making the transition for clingy babies. They will be attentive to the needs of the children.

4&5 Year Old Classroom (2) These classroom volunteers will look at the lesson during the week prior and be ready to lead the children through the different activities. (All supplies will be provided and set up for you.)

Kingdom Kids (2-4) These volunteers will look at the lesson during the week prior and be ready to lead the children through the different activities, such as music/worship, Bible, science, art and prayer. (All supplies will be provided and set up for you.)
