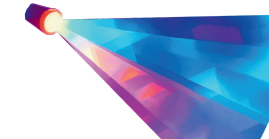
JUNE CALENDAR OF EVENTS ON ENTRY TABLE AND IN RALLY ROOM

- **2nd Sunday Fellowship** - Sun, June 14. In lieu of Sunday evening activities, Sunday School classes are encouraged to gather for fellowship.

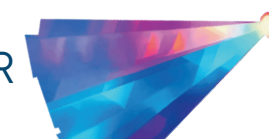
Summer Wednesdays at FBCW
