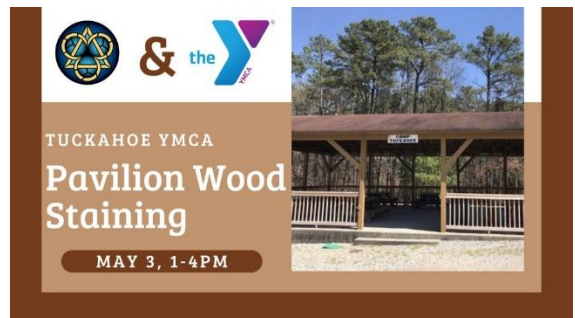
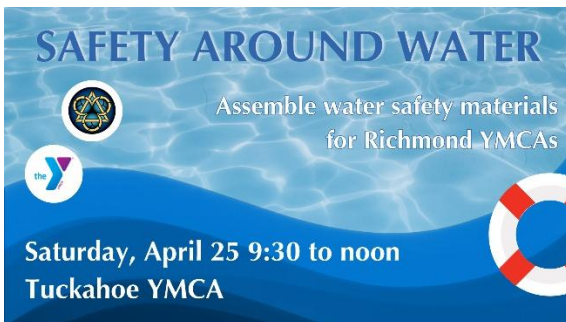


No game will be physically strenuous in any way; all abilities can participate and vie for innovative prizes. This is a great team-building opportunity!
