Sun: Supply all of the resources—both financial and the volunteer force—needed for a Kids Camp that will draw children closer to you. *"And my God will supply every need of yours according to his riches in glory in Christ Jesus" (Philippians 4:19).*

Mon: Mould the hearts and minds of every leader and volunteer so that we are able to embrace your beautiful vision for Kids Camp. *"For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts" (Isaiah 55:9).*

Tue: Transform the lives of children as they experience your love and walk with you in an eternal relationship with Jesus Christ. *"And this is eternal life, that they know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom you have sent" (John 17:3).*

Wed: Welcome unchurched children and families in our community to our Kids Camp, our church, and into a relationship with you. *"Let the children come to me; do not hinder them, for to such belongs the kingdom of God" (Mark 10:14).*

Thu: Touch the hearts of people in our congregation to step into needed volunteer roles to reach as many children as possible. *"So pray to the Lord who is in charge of the harvest; ask him to send more workers into his fields" (Matthew 9:38).*

Fri: Form meaningful friendships among children and volunteers, and (most of all) help everyone participating to develop a deep friendship with you. *"Beloved, let us love one another, for love is from God, and whoever loves has been born of God and knows God" (1 John 4:7).*

Sat: Strengthen our Kids Camp directors and each leader who is planning and preparing for this outreach. *"The Lord is my strength and my shield; in him my heart trusts, and I am helped" (Psalm 28:7).*
