Thu: Touch the hearts of people in our congregation to step into needed volunteer roles to reach as many children as possible. *“So pray to the Lord who is in charge of the harvest; ask him to send more workers into his fields” (Matthew 9:38).*

Fri: Form meaningful friendships among children and volunteers, and (most of all) help everyone participating to develop a deep friendship with you. *“Beloved, let us love one another, for love is from God, and whoever loves has been born of God and knows God” (1 John 4:7).*

Sat: Strengthen our Kids Camp directors and each leader who is planning and preparing for this outreach. *“The Lord is my strength and my shield; in him my heart trusts, and I am helped” (Psalm 28:7).*
