Holy Week begins with **Palm Sunday**, when we remember Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem and his welcome with palms and shouts of praise. Our modern-style worship service is at 9 AM, and our traditional-style worship service is at 11 AM.

We will observe **Triduum**. Triduum, which means "three days," is the ancient Christian tradition from sunset on Maundy Thursday through sunset on Easter Sunday that marks the climax of Lent and bridge into the Easter Season.

These days proclaim the mystery of Jesus Christ's passion, death, and resurrection as we journey through the upper room, to the cross, to the tomb, and into the joy of the resurrection. Though chronologically three days, liturgically Triduum is one continuous act of worship experienced over several days.

We begin with a **7 PM Maundy Thursday service**, remembering Jesus' command to love through word, prayer, and Communion in a reflective and accessible style. On **Good Friday, we gather for a 7 PM Tenebrae service**, marked by scripture, music, and the gradual extinguishing of light as we remember the crucifixion. On **Holy Saturday, there will be a virtual service released at sunset - 7:30 PM** on our Facebook, YouTube, website, and app. This short and prayerful worship experience will hold space for silence, waiting, and hope.

Triduum culminates on **Easter Sunday**, as we celebrate resurrection with an **outdoor 6:30 AM Sunrise Service, a 9 AM modern-style worship service, and an 11 AM traditional-style worship service**.

Together, these services invite us to experience the full depth of Holy Week and the joy of Easter morning.
