Samaritan Offering

Pinnacle Living is one of five health and welfare organizations connected to the Virginia Conference of the United Methodist Church. Pinnacle properties include Cedarfield, Hermitage properties, and WindsorMeade, and they provide a continuum of care for senior adults.

However, uncontrollable circumstances or longevity of life can change a resident's situation, and they may exhaust their resources while living at Pinnacle properties. **Pinnacle Living has never asked a resident to leave their home because they have exhausted their fund due to no fault of their own.** Each year, Pinnacle Living gives approximately \$400,000 in benevolent financial assistance to those of an average age of 88.

They are able to do this largely due to the Samaritan Program.
