Being The Church Tools for Small Group

"Day after day, in the temple courts and from house to house, they never stopped teaching and proclaiming the good news that Jesus is the Christ." Acts 5:42

This verse is a model of the two-wing church ... the large group wing (in the temple courts) and the small group wing (from house to house). Your small group is a church – it is a smaller expression of the larger church. It is through the church, both in the large group and the small group wings, that our five-fold mission is fulfilled:

Pursue – we pursue God's presence, worshipping Him in spirit and in truth.

Connect – we live in community, knowing others and being known.

Become – we become whole people through Christ's life in us, by the power of the Holy Spirit.

Serve – we give freely of our time and resources to meet practical needs of others.

Reach – we share the redeeming message of Jesus Christ to others.

As a small group leader, serving as a lay pastor to your group, your role is to shepherd, disciple and equip the people in your group to grow in living out these five values of being the church.
