PURSUING GOD'S PRESENCE - Small Group Resource

As believers, God has richly blessed us with a new identity and abundant promises. Praying Scripture, where we align our prayers with God's word, is a powerful way to pray! It honours God's heart for us and reminds us of his goodness.



- How have other people's prayers for you made a difference in your life?
