As a church family, which includes our small group network, there are a number of ways we can support our global partners together!

Here is a list of our global partners and some ideas for how you can encourage and support them. Invite the Holy Spirit to lead you and speak to you as you consider how to honour Him in supporting our global partners.

SAM Ministries – Janette Stone

In seeking to love God and love people, SAM Ministries trains and develops leaders and cares for children through various means. Janette works as a Child Sponsorship Coordinator with SAM Ministries. (https://samministries.org/mozambique)

Swaziland – Bulembu

We partner with the town of Bulembu, an abandoned mining town taken over for the housing of orphans in Swaziland. Bulembu also operates many viable businesses such as a honey-making operation, bottled drinking water facility, lumber mill and bakery. (https://www.bulembu.org)

El Salvador – Shelter Canada

Shelter Canada is an organization that works with families to build homes in El Salvador. Heartland's partnership with them has helped to build approximately 115 houses and raised funds for 25 more. (https://www.sheltercanada.ca)

Ways to Encourage and Support Our Global Partners

- Adopting a partner to pray for on a regular basis as a small group.
- Sponsoring a child as a family or a small group.
- Sending a care package to an international worker.
- Doing a fundraiser for a global partner in general, or a special project they are highlighting. This could include bake sales, garage sales and more!
- Sending some, or all group members on a short-term trip to serve that global partner in person.
- Having someone in your group serve as a champion for that global partner at Heartland.
- Connecting regularly with a contact working with a global partner, either through an online video call, a phone call or email, for regular updates and times of prayer.
- Anything else you and your group might come up with! These are just some initial ideas!
