1. Talk about what it mean that Jesus is truth. Why is that important to establish as a believer? How does Jesus as truth clarify reality, integrity, authority, and certainty? Does it make a difference for you?

5. Our attitude toward truth determines the outcome of our lives. If we love truth, we will love Jesus. If we resist truth, we will resist Jesus. What does that mean for salvation? What does that mean toward changing our hearts?
