3. How does Gideon's request for a sign with the fleece illustrate the tension between faith and the need for reassurance? Have you ever found yourself in need of reassurance?
4. How does Gideon's act of destroying Baal's altar demonstrate courage and faith, and what risks did he face socially and politically? Do you believe faith has an element of risk? In what area is God asking you to risk?
5. In what way does Gideon's obedience, despite hesitation, show the importance of trusting God's plan even when it seems improbable? Have you found God to work in ways you didn't anticipate? What lesson can we learn from that?
