1. What was most helpful in the message to you?
2. Daniel lived in a culture that was contentious against worship of the true God. How was that revealed in the story in Daniel 6? How did they treat Him? Did it make sense they were against a godly man? How do we find that same antagonism true and real today in America or around the world? Name some examples or ways where there is opposition to those who have faith?
3. Daniel stood for God in the midst of the opposition. What are some examples in the Bible that reveal his character even though he was despised for his faith? How was he viewed by the King? How did he respond in his spiritual life to the persecution? How do you respond when you see people opposed for their faith or your faith?
4. What do you believe causes people to hate people of faith or oppose them when they are usually people of character? What extent did these men go to trap Daniel? How do we see Christianity viewed by the ungodly today? Who might these be? Have you ever experienced opposition for standing for Christ in your work, school, or relationships? What happened?
5. We see a rescue or comeback at the end of the story. What happened to Daniel? What happened to his accusers? What can we learn from Daniel's life in this story? What does this say about God's covering over us?
