

FAFC Questions and Interaction

1. What new thing did you hear or what was most important to you in the message?
2. Describe your definition of prayer. What has been your belief in prayer? Is prayer exciting to you or somewhat dull? Do you expect that God hears or do you feel He is at a distance? Talk about your biggest block in prayer.
3. The New Testament often has a different viewpoint than how many see it. Read the verse at the top of your notes in 1 John 5:16 and share what stands out to you from John's words. What does it mean that we have a "confidence in approaching God"? Would you say that you have a confidence in approaching God? Why or why not?
4. The Bible gives many stories of people coming to God with expectations. Joshua asked that God would make the sun stand still...the blind man asked for his sight...and the lepers asked for healing. What do those requests bring to mind in our lives. Can God do great things in us?
4. Select one of the points of from the message and ask God to work that truth in your life. Begin by asking God what He wants to show you. Practice praying each of the ideas from the message. Take time this week to "approach His throne with boldness."
