

FAFC Questions

1. What most impacted you or was a new discovery from the message?
2. What does the word worship mean to you? How have you practiced worship in your life? The idea of “worship” comes the concept of “worth-ship.” Consider those things in your life you give the most worth. Why are they valuable to you? Why is it important to give worth to God?
3. Do you agree with this statement? The reason we give God worship is that He alone is worthy. In the 10 commandments, God said, “You shall have no idols before me.” Where are people tempted to put idols in our society? While idols are often seen as concrete images, they can come in many forms today. Can you names some of the biggest idols that can draw our attention in our culture?
4. In John 4, Jesus encountered the woman at the well. In the conversation with her, Jesus shared, “God is Spirit and His worshippers must worship in spirit and in truth.” (John 4:23) Do you believe it is possible to worship with spirit (passion) and without truth (wrong God)? Do you believe you can worship with truth (right God) but in without spirit (no passion)? Why is it important to have both?
5. Worship can be any act given to God including work, relationships, thoughts, and words. Do you agree or disagree? Why do we see it mainly as singing? Romans 12:1,2 says we worship by “offering ourselves as a living sacrifice...which our reasonable act of worship.” Why is that much bigger than songs? Pray that God expands your heart to worship Him.
