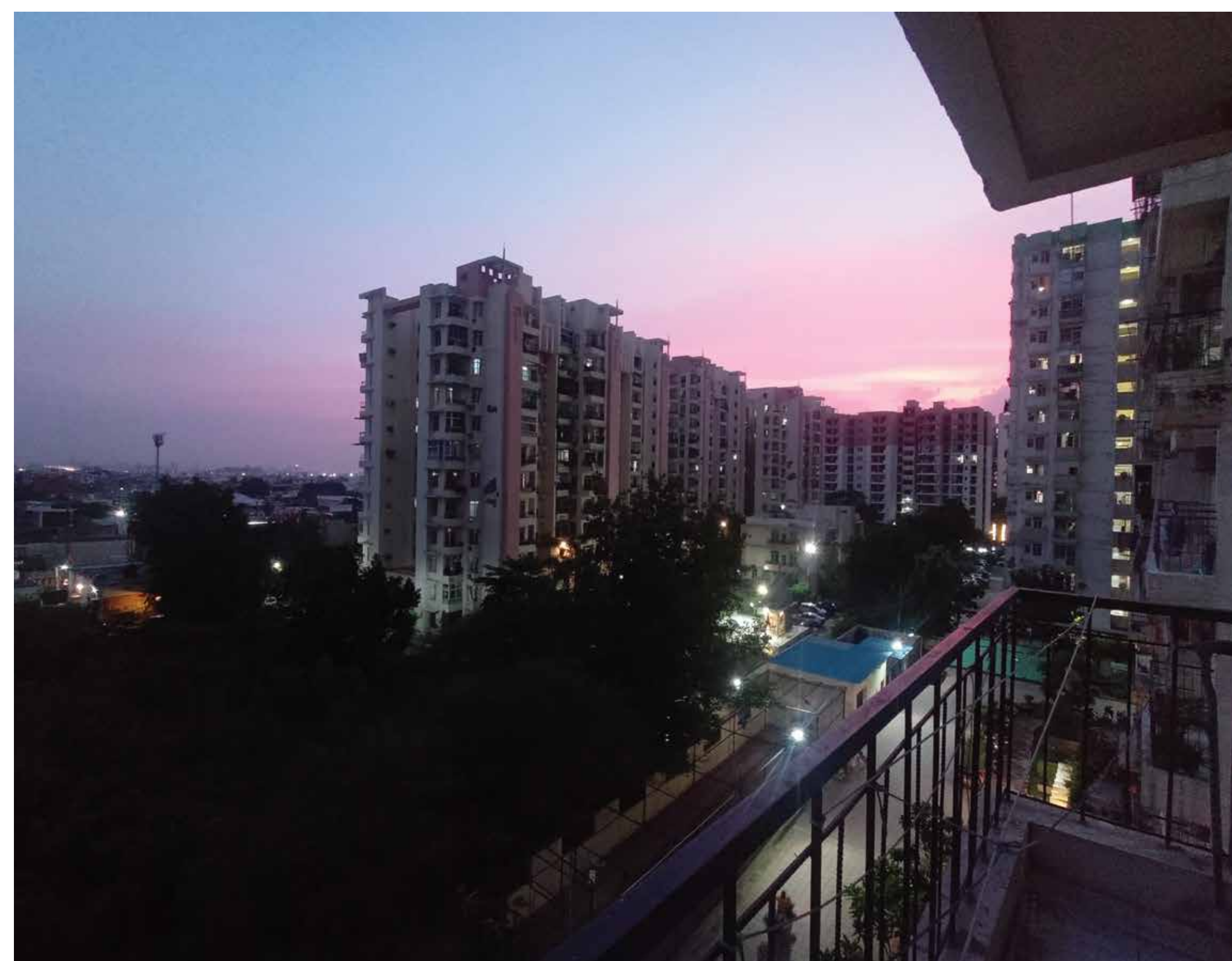


DAY 02: QUTUB MINAR & OLD DELHI NIGHT EXPERIENCE

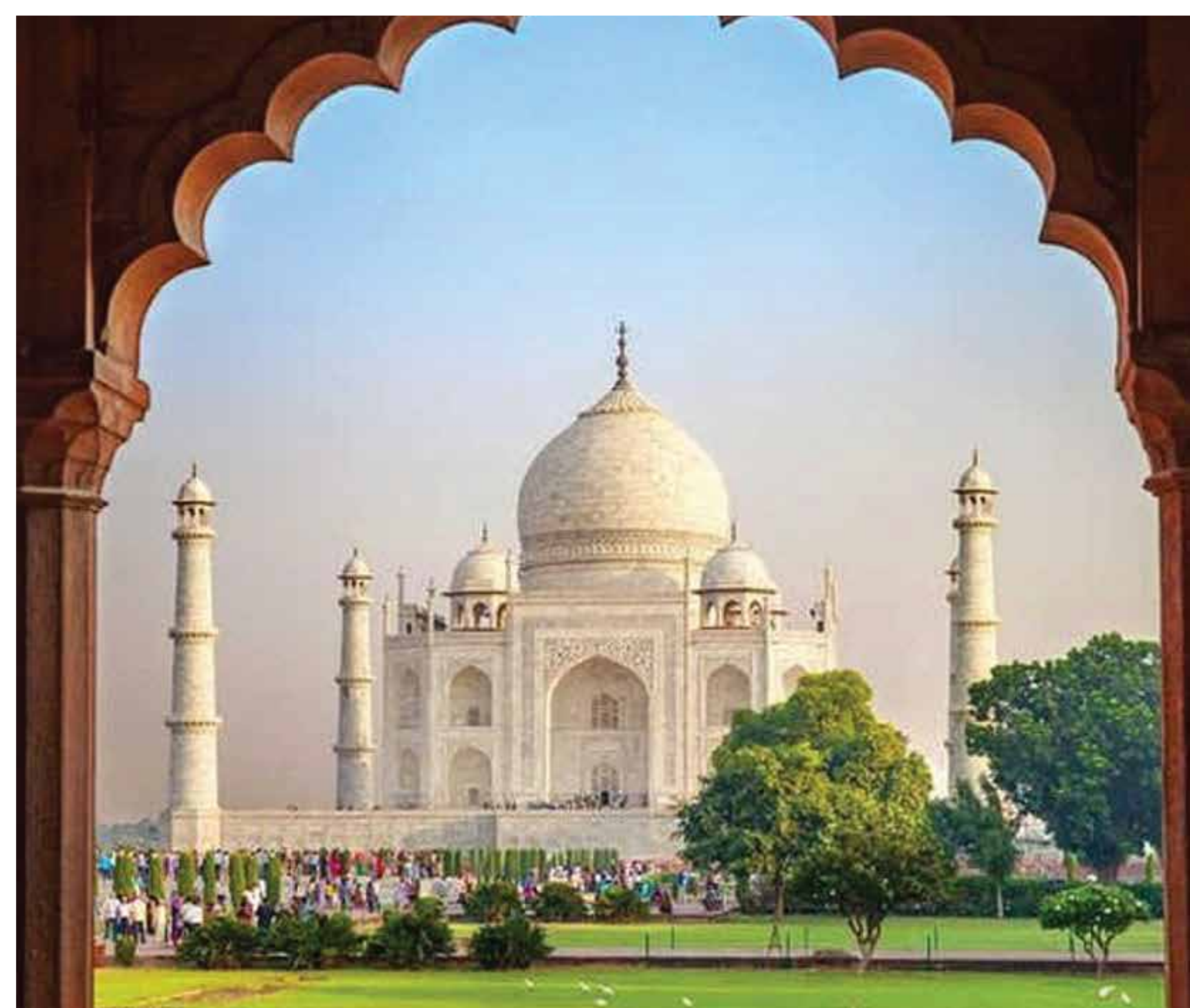


DAY 05: HANDICRAFTS & AUTHENTIC VILLAGE LIFE
