DEVOTIONAL

ONE OF THE MOST COMFORTING PHRASES IN THIS STORY IS:
“BUT **GOD** REMEMBERED NOAH...”

THIS DOES NOT MEAN **GOD** FORGOT NOAH PREVIOUSLY.
IT MEANS **GOD** REMAINED FAITHFUL TO HIS PROMISE.
SOMETIMES IN WAITING SEASONS, IT CAN FEEL LIKE **GOD**
HAS FORGOTTEN US.

BUT **GOD** NEVER ABANDONS HIS PEOPLE.
EVEN SILENCE DOES NOT MEAN ABSENCE.
GOD WORKS FAITHFULLY EVEN WHEN WE CANNOT
IMMEDIATELY SEE IT.
