55. How did they show their faith?

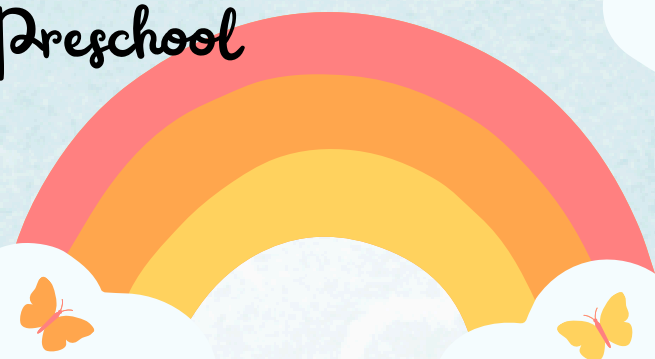
By offering sacrifices to God's altar.
