Transforming Communities through the Gospel



PIPES continues to serve as a beacon of hope to indigenous communities worldwide. Through our ministry, we are making disciples, addressing poverty, and empowering families toward financial independence.

In 2022, we completed the translation of our Discipleship Pathway Workbook into eight languages, now used across seven countries. This has strengthened local churches, including one in Kanjinji village, Kenya, which has grown significantly as members are equipped to evangelize and disciple others.

Our mission teams have reached communities across multiple countries, sharing the gospel and training leaders. Thousands have responded, and many lives continue to be transformed. At the same time, we support over 1,000 vulnerable children with education and meals.

We also empower women through small businesses and farming support, helping families move from dependency to stability. In times of crisis, we have provided food, healthcare, and relief to vulnerable communities, including refugees.

All of this is made possible through the faithful support of our partners. We are deeply grateful for your role in helping us serve as the hands and feet of Jesus.

Empowering Women in Africa.



Women in rural African communities play a significant role in providing for their families. We have witnessed indigenous women working so hard for so little, thus struggling to feed their families. PIPES International resolved to empower these women through training and initiating small businesses. Since many of them are uneducated, vocational training was appropriate for them. PIPES is partnering with local churches in Rwanda, Burundi, and Pakistan to train women in dressmaking and tailoring. We now have four schools in Rwanda, Burundi, and Pakistan. We have 20 students studying in Rwanda, 10 in Burundi, and 20 in Pakistan. In Pakistan, we have two sewing schools in operation and have graduated approximately 50 students so far.

Last year, we graduated the first students in Rwanda. PIPES International has provided five sewing machines to five women to start small businesses.

It's exciting to see women without hope transitioning to businesswomen and seeking suitable employment. We look forward to expanding the sewing schools by installing more sewing machines and enrolling more women who have expressed the desire to learn.

Responding to the crisis in Ukraine



The Bible calls on Christians to help those in need. It is especially hurting to see so many children and women in a desperate situation like the Ukraine invasion. During our visit to Moldova in August 2022, I listened to passionate stories of how Ukrainian families escaped death and terror. It was very emotional to listen to the narratives, watch videos, and look at pictures the people took as they escaped. Sergei (pictured right) narrated how he was separated from his family, and finally, they reunited in Cupcini, a small city in Moldova. During the mission trip, we distributed food to hundreds of refugees and conducted a medical camp where over 300 were treated. About 150 people said Yes to Jesus during the mission trip.





Evangelizing & Making Disciples of All Nations

We are called to make disciples of all nations. Today, many false prophets are preaching for selfish gains. To help people be rooted in Christ, PIPES has published a discipleship workbook translated into eight (8) languages. The workbook is now being used in six countries and online meetings.

We have also introduced reading through the New Testament in one year through our new workbook, encouraging people to read the New Testament in one year.

Colossians 3:16

Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.

We have formed bible study groups in different countries where believers study God's word regularly. Believers are growing in faith and will continue to make disciples who will also make other disciples.

2 Timothy 2:2:

"And the things you have heard me say in the presence of many witnesses entrust to reliable people who will also be qualified to teach others"

This scripture is becoming a reality in our ministry context.



Supporting Farmers in Burundi

Burundi is currently the poorest nation on earth. The need to support locals with training, seeds, and manure to grow food and support families is inevitable. In 2022, PIPES supported about 250 farmers with seeds, manure, and training. Over the last two years, we've seen an increase in production. Food security is a vital part of the transformation, and we have witnessed improved health conditions among children and families since we started supporting Burundi farmers.



The Idjwi school construction taking shape



Education is one of the most critical investments in the lives of children. When children get an education, they have opportunities in the future to improve their lives and their community too. Our new school in Idjwi Island will give hope to over 250 students. Many children who had no hope of attending school are excited because they can get an education. In April 2022, we began the construction of six classrooms to help over 300 children who struggle to get quality education. When complete, we will move students from a current makeshift (see photo below) to a permanent building.
